Transmissions
Not transmitted. Individuals are transmitted by eggs that are passed in the faeces of infected persons.
These eggs concentrate in soil.
This can happen in several ways:
1. Eggs that are attached to vegetables are ingested when the vegetables are not carefully washed, washed, or cooked.
2. Eggs are ingested from contaminated water sources.
3. Eggs are ingested by children who play in the contaminated soil and then put their hands in their mouths without washing them.
4. People working barefoot on the contaminated soil (even if they do not penetrate the skin).

Control
The strategy for control of hookworms is to prevent the person from coming in contact with the contaminated soil. Keep the environment clean.
